What to do if you suspect abuse has happened or is likely to happen:

1. Listen to any disclosure carefully.
2. Stay calm, try not to show shock and reassure the pupil.
3. Don't prompt or seek more information than is absolutely necessary.
4. Don't make promises – tell pupil you will have to pass the information on.
5. Record carefully what has happened or been said.
6. Report your concern to a safeguarding officer as soon as possible.
7. Complete a 'CPOMS' form and pass it on to HL, FC or OJ.
